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Welcome to the second edition of the ESIRAS eBulletin. Its main purpose is to keep ESIRAS partners informed about project progress, key milestones and events, success stories and innovative strategies from the field to improve the labor market and social integration of refugees and asylum seekers.

Stories, news, tools, resources and relevant information on labor market and social integration of refugees and asylum seekers in the seven ESIRAS cities are more than welcome!

First ESIRAS Regional Coordination Meeting

Around 20 participants representing the eight ESIRAS European Red Cross National Societies, the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies (IFRC) and representatives from the Directorate-General for Employment, Social Affairs and Inclusion of the European Commission (DG EMPL) attended the First Regional Coordination Meeting that was hosted by the Italian Red Cross in Milan.

ESIRAS local projects shared information on the progress made and the activities they are implementing and discussed in working groups on topics such as intermediation and engagement, project monitoring and reporting, women engagement in ESIRAS activities, and sustainability. Two dashboards were introduced at the meeting. These new ESIRAS tools capture and present an updated overview on three key elements of the project: participants' profiles, implemented activities and participant's individual records.

Second Quarterly Report

By June 30th, ESIRAS integration centres were open and providing services in all seven ESIRAS locations. In the second quarter there were 286 active participants, from which 194 new participants were registered in Q2 (53 women and 141 men). 218 participants received skills training, 19 were enrolled in vocational trainings and 16 completed and internship. In total, 315 participants have registered in both Q1 and Q2, which accounts for 26% of the project target.

PRE-LABOUR WORKSHOPS

The Styrian branch of the Austrian Red Cross supports individuals to access employment through workshops and one-to-one consultations. Newly revised and updated job application materials and tailored support to prepare for the job interview have enabled a number of ESIRAS participants the chance to gain their first experience in the workplace. They were allocated placements as part of the ESIRAS Programme. All the participants successfully completed their work placements.





SUMMER SCHOOL

During the summer months, the Styrian branch of the Austrian Red Cross offered an intensive Summer School for ESIRAS participants.

Numerous German courses and workshops took place during this period. Lessons outdoors on warmer days were a particular highlight of the programme and a welcome change for participants! ③.

INNOVATIVE PARTNERSHIPS

As part of the Langer Tag der Flucht, the Styrian Red Cross together with the <u>Talenteküche</u>, another initiative that supports the integration of refugees and migrants into the labor market, organized an event called <u>'ESIRAS goes Talenteküche'</u>. The aim of the event was to create discussions, sharing of ideas and new networking possibilities. This year's theme was world cuisine and many prominent guests attended the event, such as the President of the Austrian Red Cross, employers from the field of Hospitality and Catering, representatives from the world of business, the Austrian Employment Service (AMS) and other organizations.

NATIONAL SOCIETY INVOLVEMENT

A second ESIRAS Slovenia office was open in Maribor. Volunteers and local branch staff assisted in the renovation of the office space. A joint one-day seminar for ESIRAS beneficiaries was organized in Novo mesto in collaboration with local staff. ESIRAS Slovenia also joined forces with Ljubljana local branch in the preparation of a social picnic/crafts workshop for women beneficiaries of its social inclusion programme - <u>Srečevalnica</u>.

PROFESSIONAL TRAININGS

In July, four beneficiaries successfully completed a dry-wall construction vocational course with the support of an ESIRAS interpreter and volunteers. Beneficiaries also continued with preparations for driver's first aid exam and national driving license tests. In September, a new group of beneficiaries started preparations for their driving license.

LIFESKILLS

The second *Lifeskills* class started on 18 July and ran for eight weeks. 23 participants completed the course, attending English classes, *Lifeskills* sessions about systems and culture in the UK and social activities. The group learned how to use the free citybike scheme and went on a day's cycling trip to the Scottish coast! When the programme finished, the Move-on caseworker helped young people get places in an English language course at a college. 21 participants are now attending classes.



PARTNERSHIP

15 participants have been supported so far through the partnership with Bridges Programmes. A variety of placements have been offered to suit ESIRAS participants' skills and experience. These include placements at: a carpet manufacturer's, a local nursery school, an animal welfare organization, a vet practice, a care home, Glasgow Community Initiative Food Initiative and of course the British Red Cross charity shops.

Jelling

MOTIVATIONAL INTERVIEWING TRAINING

In August the ESIRAS team in Jelling participated in a two-days training about Motivational Interviewing (MI). The training was designed to improve motivation among ESIRAS participants, which has been a challenge in Jelling. MI is a client based methodology which provides tools for listening for the motivation between the lines, when interviewing and communicating with the participants.



MI is about careful and active listening focusing on the small signs of motivation to change status quo in the participant, and then to build further communication on that.

PROFESSIONAL TRAININGS

A first group of 14 participants successfully completed their professional training course to be employed by the food service industry, fully funded by Esiras, of which 11 will participate in an internship program. Another 7 participants have recently started a course in buildings refurbishment and maintenance and 7 more are enrolled in a professional training for the food service industry. In addition, two new trainings will soon begin to develop skills as a warehouse worker.

VOLUNTEERING
